Prerequisites for Certification as an Ohio Assistant EMT Instructor:

- Completion of an 8 hour Assistant EMT Instructor Course
- Either:
 - EMS Special Topics To Assistant Instructor Path:
 - Valid Special Topics Instructor as of 02/01/2009 and apply by 03/01/2010
 - Completion of Practical Skills Exam within past 3 years.
 - Delivery of at least 10 hours instruction in presence of EMT Instructor within past 3 years.
 - EMS Assistant Instructor Direct Path:
 - Completion of Practical Skills Exam within past 3 years.
 - Completion of Knowledge Exam within past 3 years.
 - Delivery of at least 10 hours instruction in presence of EMT Instructor.

Practical skills exam available through UC-Raymond Walters prior to instructor class.

Minimum 8 students required to hold class, maximum size 16 students. Additional classes will be offered at various locations if demand exists – see contact below.
