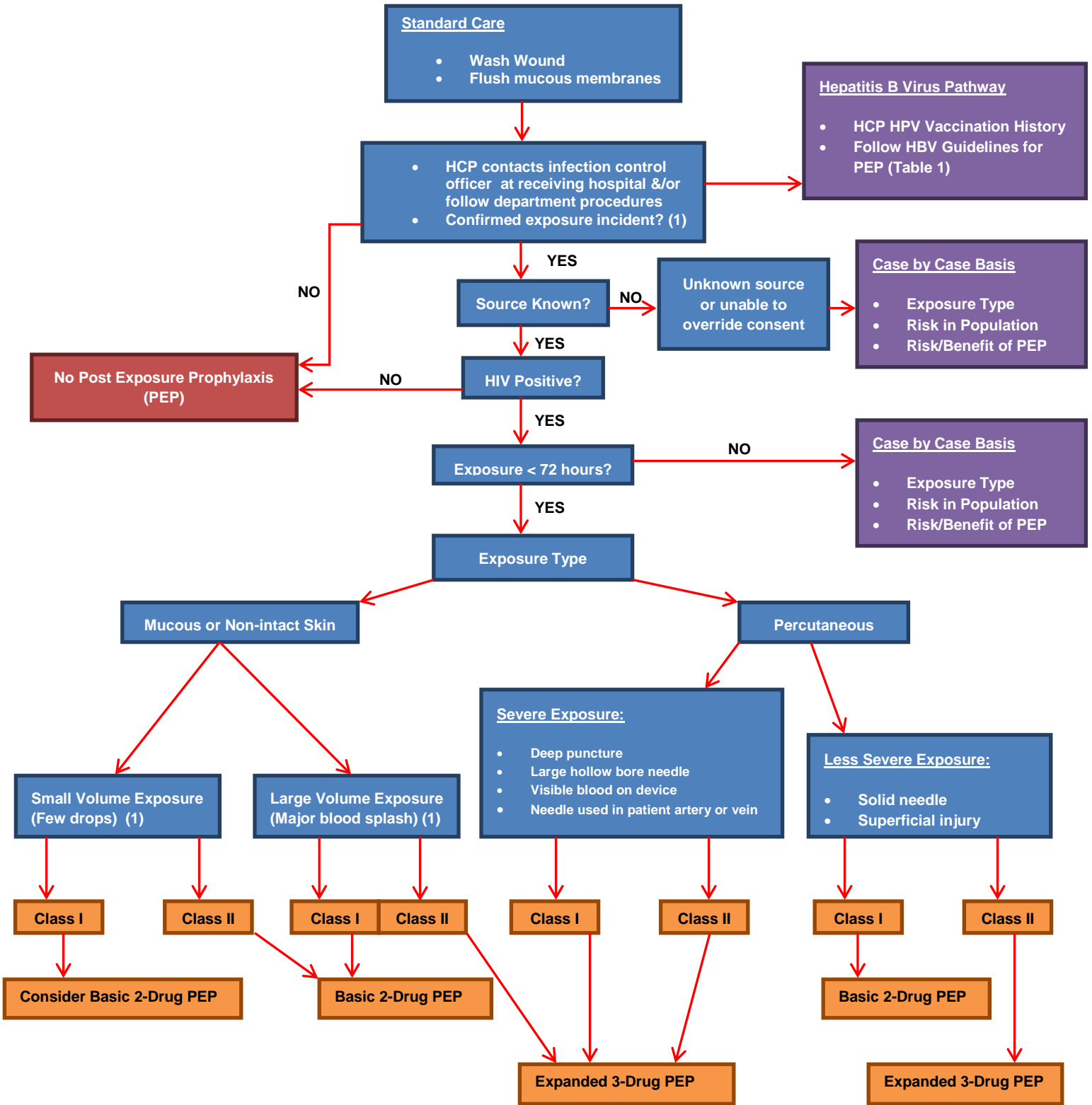


**Health Care Provider (HCP) Occupational Exposure**



<b>Class I:</b> asymptomatic HIV or viral load <1500 copies/mL	<b>Class II:</b> symptomatic, AIDS, acute seroconversion, high viral load

<b>Generally No PEP/Case by Case Basis:</b> Generally no PEP warranted for Unknown Source Cases or Exposure >72 hours, but may consider Basic PEP based on Source Risk Factors: rape, sex for money, IV drug abuse, or men having sex with men.
